**ORDER FOR FIREARMS RETURN**

This cause having come to be heard pursuant to the Respondent’s Motion to Retrieve Firearm(s) in the above styled cause, and the Court having reviewed all pertinent documents, finds as follows:

1. The Respondent was ordered to surrender all firearms in his/her possession pursuant to a valid Protective Order.
2. The firearm(s) surrendered may be described as, and the serial number(s) of said firearm(s) are as follows:

7. There is no injunction in effect against the Respondent in Texas or any other state;
8. There is no forfeiture action pending against Respondent in another court;

9. The Respondent has never been adjudicated mentally defective or been committed to a mental institution; and
10. There is not a legal impediment to the Respondent owning or possessing a firearm, including but not limited to those mentioned above.

Based upon the foregoing findings, it is hereby ORDERED that the Respondent's Motion to Retrieve Firearm(s) is GRANTED and the law enforcement agency which has retained said firearm(s) is to return the above described firearm(s) to the Respondent, upon presentation of a certified copy of this order, the surrender receipt (property receipt), proof of ownership, and valid identification of the Respondent.

**If the Respondent does not take this Order to law enforcement in order to have his/her firearm returned within 90 days of the expiration of the Protective Order, the firearm may be destroyed.**
