



## **El Paso County Risk Pool Board**

**The El Paso County Government has an opening on its Risk Pool Board and is calling for a member of the El Paso Community to volunteer and be part of the 5 member-body.**

**The County Risk Pool Board's primary duty is to supervise the operations of the Risk Pool fund.**

**The board also serves as an advisory body to the Commissioners Court, develops general policies, takes action on benefit complaints, reviews and approves the annual budget, and considers recommendations from a third party administrator, legal counsel, consultants, and staff.**

**The County is looking for individuals with experience in various backgrounds, including but not limited to health care or health and wellness administration, human resources, finance, and/or business management.**

**Applicants must be willing to attend monthly board meetings which are generally 3 to 4 hours in length. Applicants will also be required to complete the County's Ethics training and comply with County Code of Ethics. Applicants must be El Paso County residents and should not be in a position that would present a conflict of interest. Terms of office are two years. The current term will expire in May/2013.**
