<b>INTERMEDIATE ACCIDENT INVESTIGATION: (40 hrs) TCLEOSE 2070</b> This course introduces the officer to basic drawing skills needed for scale diagrams at the scene of a vehicle crash and presents five formulas that can be used to determine the minimum speed of the vehicle based on skid and/or yaw marks to calculate combined speeds. <b>Requirements: Scientific Calculator, a 100 ft. tape measure, and mechanical or wood pencil(s) with a lead measurement of 0.5mm. <b>SURVIVAL DEFENSIVE TACTICS: (8 hrs) TCLEOSE 2040</b> for <i>El Paso County Sheriff's Office Civilian employees Only!</i> This course will give students a good foundation and working knowledge of techniques that will help them survive and prevail in an altercation. The ground fighting techniques taught in this training will cover escapes, takedowns, preventing takedowns, ground defense and defense against the neck restraint. This course is open to all civilian employees who have not attended a defensive driving course in the past two years. It covers techniques for defensive driving to enhance the driver's awareness while on the road. This course is not for ticket dismissal. <b>Coordinator: G. <b>BLACKBOARD TRAINING (ORIENTATION): (8 hrs) TCLEOSE 3854</b> This course will familiarize the student with the Blackboard Online Training System. <b>INTERMEDIATE SPANISH (CHALLENGE EXAM): (4 hrs) TCLEOSE 2110</b> This course is a TCLEOSE requirement for Intermediate <b>PEACE OFFICER &amp; JAILER</b> Certification. This is a challenge exam; officers that pass the exam will receive <b>20 hours of TCLEOSE credit</b> . <b>Coordinator: R. Perales Instructor: C. Pierce</b>		21	
<b>DAY FIREARMS QUALIFICATIONS: (NO TCLEOSE CREDIT) Mandatory for Detention Officers of the El Paso County Sheriff's Office who carry a handgun in their duty assignment.</b> New Annual Qualification period for 2012 training cycle. Armed Officers assigned to shotguns and/or rifles will qualify with all weapons when attending. <b>Requirement:</b> Must wear long sleeve. <b>NO OVERTIME</b> <b>Coordinator/Instructor:E. Bunton</b> <b>Qualification times are as follows: 0800, 1000, and 1300 Hrs.</b>	9	14	18
<b>BASIC SHOTGUN CERTIFICATION: (16 hrs) TCLEOSE 2055 for El Paso County Sheriff's Office Detention Officers Only.</b> This is a basic certification course. It is required for those persons who will be carrying a shotgun on duty or using a shotgun during the course assignment. <i>This is Not a Re-Certification course or practice.</i> <b>Pre-requisite:</b> Not prohibited by state or federal law or rule from attending training by the commission suspended or revoked. Currently hold a Jailers License and must have Psychological Evaluation cleared by Human Resources. <b>Students are required to bring the shotguns from their respective duty assignments.</b> The Academy <b>will not</b> provide the weapons. <b>Coordinator/Instructor: E. <b>SEXUAL ASSAULT FAMILY VIOLENCE INVESTIGATOR COURSE: (24 hrs) TCLEOSE 2364</b> This course is designed to provide law enforcement officers with the tools they need to effectively investigate and prevent sexual assault and family violence. This training is designed to satisfy the legislatively mandated course of Special Investigative Topics (3232) and successful students will be eligible for a TCLEOSE proficiency certificate for advanced investigation. <b>Coordinator: R. <b>COUNTY CORRECTIONS FIREARMS COURSE: (40 hrs) TCLEOSE 3599 for El Paso County Sheriff's Office Detention Officers Only!</b> Designed to provide the students with the information and skills required to use a firearm in the performance of Correctional Duties. <b>Pre-requisite:</b> Not prohibited by state or federal law or rule from attending training related to firearms or from possessing a firearm. Never had a license or certificate issued by the commission suspended or revoked. Currently hold a Jailers License and must have Psychological Evaluation cleared by Human Resource. <b>Coordinator/Instructor: E. Bunton Limited to 18 students Location: Firing Range Time:0800-1700 **Minimum Level**</b>			7-11
<b>BASIC DETENTION OFFICER RIFLE COURSE: (24 hrs) TCLEOSE 3300</b> This is a basic course that introduces the corrections officer to the nomenclature, care, operation and qualifying of the department issued AR-15. Officers <b>MUST</b> bring the individual issued rifle in order to attend and qualify. Minimal class room time therefore please <b>dress in range/outdoor attire.</b> Assigned hand guns are required for this course. <b>Prerequisite:</b> Correction Officer. <b>Coordinator/Instructor: R. <b>AED/CPR RE-CERTIFICATION: (4 hrs) TCLEOSE 3800 for El Paso County Sheriff's Office Personnel Only!</b> This is a <u>Re-certification</u> course that will review the use of AED with CPR based on the 2010 Updates. <b>Coordinator/Instructor: G. <p style="text-align: center;"><b>E-Training</b></p> <p><b>CALEA: (2 hrs) TCLEOSE 3754 for <i>El Paso County Sheriff's Office Personnel ONLY!</i> Mandatory for all personnel working within the law enforcement bureaus. CALEA standards require employees working in the law enforcement divisions to attend <i>refresher</i> training on CALEA prior to the re-accreditation, during the self-assessment phase. This course was developed to accommodate this requirement. <b>Coordinator/Instructor: George Holden Limited to 25 students</b></b></p>	Sept. 25 Through Oct. 01		
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>E-Training</b></p> <p><b>INTERMEDIATE INMATE RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES: (16 hrs) TCLEOSE 3502 This course is a TCLEOSE requirement for <u>JAILER Proficiency Intermediate Certification</u>. This course will provide the officer with the history of the Constitution and its amendments in order to provide a better understanding of the rights and privileges inmates possess. The course will go into the differences between a right and a privilege. The course additionally provides the officer with case law and established precedence. <b>Coordinator/Instructor: George Holden Limited to 25 students</b></b> <b>(This course is now open to outside agencies)</b></p>		02-15	
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>E-Training</b></p> <p><b>INTERMEDIATE INMATE SUICIDE DETECTION AND PREVENTION IN A JAIL SETTING: (8 hrs) TCLEOSE 3501</b> Detention officers must be able to recognize the signs and symptoms of a potential suicidal inmate in order to take preventative measure in the prevention of a suicide attempt. This course is designed to train the officer on early warning signs and symptoms an inmate may possess. The training will help the officer to take a proactive approach to identifying and preventing suicidal attempts in a jail setting. The course will make the officer aware of potential liabilities that may occur when suicides are successful in a facility. The officer will additionally become aware of the state and national statistics on suicides in lockups. <b>Coordinator/Instructor: George Holden Limited to 25 students</b> <b>(This course is now open to outside agencies)</b></p>		16-22

Peace officers holding an Intermediate certification or higher are exempt from this provision. This course will provide the officers with the basic knowledge of supervision and processing of persons who are arrested or detained in a room, space, holding cell, or area for the purpose of processing, questioning, or testing. ### Physical Fitness Requirement

\*\* Some courses offered by the El Paso County Sheriff's Office Region VIII Training Academy will require a degree of physical fitness.

- **Minimum Level-** This level will consist of walking, stepping, and very light cardiovascular exercise.
- **Medium Level-** This level will consist of Jogging, minimal levels of calisthenics i.e. push-ups, sit-ups, side straddle hop, beginning levels of hands on classes i.e. PPCT and O.C.
- **Maximum Level-** This level will consist of running, sprinting, advanced calisthenics, advanced levels of hands on classes i.e. mobile field force, physical fitness exams.
- **Medium and maximum-** levels will require a blood pressure screening and students who do not pass will not be allowed to participate without a doctor's release on file.
